❖ **Question**

Dear Deacon Jim,

What is happening at the Vatican? Pope Francis told President Biden that he is a "Good Catholic" and Nancy Pelosi was able to receive Holy Communion at a Vatican Mass even though they are ardent supporters of abortion.

❖ **Response**

This is certainly a valid question and one which may lead to confusion on the part of many individuals. We do not know what was discussed in the meeting between President Biden and Pope Francis. In an interview with Univision and Televisan, Pope Francis stated he considers President Biden's position on abortion an *"incoherence"*. As for the defense of abortion, Francis said that he leaves it to Biden's *"conscience"*. Francis also stated, *"Let (Biden) talk to his pastor about that incoherence"*. This would also apply to Mrs. Pelosi and all other Catholic politicians who may be advocates of the pro-abortion stance.

There has been no change in the position of the Vatican or Church teachings regarding this issue. Any differences you feel may be attributed to the papacy of Pope Francis which tends to be more apostolic.
